



1. Do I need to submit an application every semester?

- Yes, you must submit a MG application every semester (Fall/Spring) and every term (Winter/Summer) that you will be taking courses. You *cannot* combine a semester and term into one application.
- Example: If you submit an application for the Fall semester, you must submit another one for the Winter term.
- Example: If you submit an application for the Fall semester, you must submit another one for the Spring semester.

2. Can I combine sub-terms into one application?

- Yes. We have sub-terms within a semester (Fall/Spring). If you are taking courses in different sub-terms, you may combine the units and turn in one application.
- Example: If you are taking 3 units in Fall 1 and 3 units in Fall 2, you may submit one application and state you are taking 6 units for the Fall semester.

3. Can I change my schedule after I turn in my application?

- Yes, you may change your schedule by either adding or dropping a course. However, you will need to contact us to have your hold removed.
- If you plan to add a course, you must submit a new application with updated class hours and a new signature from your Commanding Officer.

4. When should I turn in my LES?

- Since this grant is reserved for active participants in good standing, we require you to turn in a LES with your application. You are only required to submit your LES once per academic year.
- Example: If you submitted your MG application and your LES during the Fall semester, then you do not need to submit another LES for the Spring semester or the Winter/Summer terms.

5. Why do I have a registration hold?

- We have placed the "Financial Aid" hold on your account. This hold is not due to a lack of action on your end, nor does it communicate that you are in any trouble with our institution. Rather, it is a means of requiring communication with our office for any change of degree or schedule.
- Your hold may be removed once you submit your application and LES (if needed). Please wait at least 48 hours for us to review your application and remove the hold. Once the hold is lifted, please complete your course registration as soon as possible.
