Fall 2026 Art Classes for Children:
How to Draw from Life by Learning to Keep a Sketchbook

This course for students aged 6 through the 8th grade will consist of six one-hour sessions. During the class meetings the instructor will teach the students to draw quickly to capture an initial sketch of still life objects, objects from photos, and/or objects in their environment in their personal sketchbooks (supplied by the teacher) and to go back to add more details slowly afterwards.

The class will be using pencils, pens, colored pencils, markers, and a few other mediums to draw and capture different things in their sketchbooks together. These materials will also be supplied by the teacher.

The teacher will keep the students' sketchbooks for the duration of the course, but, at the end of the course, each student will each be given his/her personal sketchbook to keep, so he/she can continue to use the skills developed in the class to draw objects from real life wherever they find themselves.
