Purpose of Internship

The internship will allow students to network in the areas of Islam and missions and allow an opportunity for professional development. The available ministries include communications, events, and research/writing. This means the intern will be in the center for 4 hours per week, completing the tasks given to them upon the choosing of the focus of their program. Interns should be present at all Jenkins Center events, in which they will receive personal time with most speakers as the staff/interns dialogue about Islam and the issues we are facing today. Interns should be increasing in their knowledge of Islam through the reading given, in order to best answer questions from students who come into the center.

- Applicants must be enrolled in a bachelor's level program or above at Southern Seminary or Boyce College.
- Applicants should have a keen interest in studying Islam and Muslim evangelism.

General Responsibilities

Interns will serve 4 hours a week in the Jenkins Center for two full semesters (Fall and Spring). Interns will attend all Jenkins Center events.
