Notes: Required courses are in bold face type. All courses are six weeks in length. Terms I-II meet consecutively from late August through mid-November. Terms III-IV meet consecutively from late January or early February through late April. Specific dates are available included with other important details in the course descriptions found prior to each semester on our webpage as well as on my.sbts.edu where students register. A one week break is scheduled in the fall and in the spring.

We offer a Wednesday morning section of Discipleship I-II each fall. Students may take both the Wednesday morning class and a Thursday night class simultaneously, if desired. Childcare will be available for AM classes as well as PM classes.

We suggest you attempt to plan your course selection so you will be sure to complete the required courses and be able to choose your electives accordingly. The schedule is subject to change as new courses are added but we do our best not to move required classes.

Our Family Life Conference is a required course. Both husband and wife must attend this event, held on a Friday night and Saturday morning in mid September in even numbered years. A flyer with details will be posted on our webpage starting in May of even numbered years.
