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Statement of Understanding



Please read the following information below and initial each item to acknowledge your understanding.

The Military Grant covers \$250 per credit hour, up to a maximum of \$4,500 per academic year. The grant is for tuition only and not applicable to any other fees (student enrollment, internet, health services, technology, observation, TEP, graduation, etc.).	
Student must be an active participant in good standing in the Armed Forces (including National Guard or Reserves).	
Student has not received 9 or more AWOLS in the previous twelve months.	
Student must notify the Financial Aid Office if his/her enlistment/commission will expire during the given academic year.	
Students must be enrolled in a degree program, be in good academic standing, and maintain a 3.0+ GPA.	
Only courses required for the student's degree plan are covered by the grant.	
Student must receive a passing grade for all courses covered by the grant. The grant will be reversed for failed courses.	
The Military Grant may be used towards only one degree program at Southern Seminary or Boyce College . Upon graduation, students may not receive the Military Grant for future studies at Southern Seminary or Boyce College.	
The Military Grant can only be used for undergraduate or master's degrees. Seminary Track, ThM, and Doctoral degrees are not eligible for the grant .	
Student must submit an application along with a current LES once per academic year prior to the Fall semester or at the first use of the grant.	
The "Financial Aid" registration hold on a student's account is due to this grant. Students may change schedules by either adding or dropping a course. However, students will need to contact the Financial Aid Office to have their hold removed.	
The application deadline for students continuing on the grant is August 1 of every academic year. The application deadline for new students is as follows: Fall 1 - August 1; Fall 2 - October 1 Winter - December 1 Spring 1 - January 1; Spring 2 - April 1 Summer - June 1
