- This conference is a required course for graduation from SWI. You only take it one time during your time here.
- **Dr. and Mrs. Hershael York** will team teach this tremendous conference. (There will be a break out session on Saturday morning for wives with Mrs. Tanya York while the men have a separate session with Dr. York.)
- Childcare will be provided for both sessions on a first come basis at a cost of \$ 2 per child per session. **We encourage everyone to do their best to arrange childcare on their own.** A child care request form will be available in August on our webpage for this event. This is completely separate from the request for child care during weekly SWI classes.
- Registration fee is just \$20 per couple. This includes one bound study guide as well as the meals!
- Both sessions will be held on campus in Heritage Hall.
- Alums of previous conferences may request to attend again and will be admitted as space allows and in order of date request was made. We will let you know ASAP!
- Upon completion of a 1-2 page written reflection paper, one credit will be given towards the Certificate of Ministry Studies through Seminary Wives Institute.
- PAYMENT of the \$20 registration fee is **required** by September 1 and is **non-refundable**. Since substantial funding is given for the full dinners and buffet breakfast for couples during this event, we will charge a \$50 fee for those who are confirmed for this event but do not show up.
